Referee Declarations & Invoice

The undersigned Referee hereby makes the following declarations to the Independent School District #1 of McClain County, OK d/b/a Newcastle Public Schools:

(1) As required by Section 6-101.48 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, Referee declares that he or she has never been convicted in this state or another state of any sex offense subject to the **Sex Offenders Registration Act** or is subject to another state's or the federal sex offender registration provisions.

Referee further understands that Title 57, O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 589 provides as follows:

It is unlawful for any person registered pursuant to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act or the Mary Rippy Violent Crime Offenders Registration Act to work with or provide services to children or to work on school premises, or for any person or business which contracts for work to be performed on school premises to knowingly and willfully allow any employee to work with children or to work on school premises who is registered pursuant to the Oklahoma Sex Offenders Registration Act or the Mary Rippy Violent Crime Offenders Registration Act. Upon conviction for any violation of the provisions of this subsection, the violator shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). In addition, the violator may be liable for civil damages.

(2) As detailed by District Board Policies BB and BE, Newcastle Public Schools is a <u>tobacco-free</u> and <u>weapons-free</u> workplace for all schools, buildings and grounds whether leased or owned by the District. Referee understands that use of any tobacco products or possession of a weapon while in or on any of the aforementioned locations is prohibited. Violations will result in Referee being prohibited from working for Newcastle Public Schools in the future.

Referee declares that so long as he or she performs work for or provides services to the Independent School District #1 of McClain County, OK d/b/a Newcastle Public Schools, that he or she will at all times comply with the provisions described herein.

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.
